

Your Prosperity Is In God

Overview: God's prosperity belongs to you but it is hidden in Christ Jesus, revealed only to those in the family of God. It is manifested to His children who know their rights.

A. How Prosperous Is God?

- 1. God made everything.
 - Isa 45:12 I have made the earth, and created man upon it: I, even my hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded.
 - Isa 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is none else.
- 2. God owns everything.
 - Psa 24:1 The earth is the LORD'S, the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.
 - Psa 50:10 For every beast of the forest is mine, and the cattle upon a thousand hills.
 - Psa 50:12 If I were hungry, I would not tell thee: for the world is mine, and the fulness thereof.
- 3. God is extravagant.
 - Gen 2:11 The first is Pison: which compasses the whole land of Havilah, where there is gold.
 - Rev 21:18 And the building of the wall of it was of jasper: and the city was pure gold.
 - Hag 2:8 The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of Hosts.
 - Gen 13:2 And Abram was very rich in cattle, in silver, and in gold.
 - Gen 39:3 And his master saw that the LORD was with Joseph, and that the LORD made all that he did to prosper in his hand.
 - Lev 20:24 But I have said unto you, Ye shall inherit their land, and I will give it unto you to possess it, a land that floweth with milk and honey: I am the LORD your God.

B. Your Prosperity Is Hidden In Christ

- 1. Hidden from the Beginning.
 - Eph 3:8 I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ.
 - Eph 3:9 And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:
 - Rom 16:25 Now to him that is of power to establish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began.
- 2. Revealed to the Family of God.
 - Mar 4:11 And he said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God: but unto them that are without, all these things are done in parables.
 - Rom 16:26 But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of faith.
- 3. Beyond our mental understanding.
 - 1Co 2:7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory.
 - 1Co 2:9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.
 - 1Co 2:10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searches all things, yea, the deep things of God.
 - Col 1:27 To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.



C. Your Rights in Christ

1. Redeemed from the Curse of the Law.

Gal 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

Gal 3:14 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

2. The Blessings of Abraham belong to us.

Psa 68:19 Blessed be the Lord, who daily loads us with benefits.

Isa 45:3 And I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and **hidden riches** of secret places, that thou may know that I, the LORD, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel.

Isa 48:17 Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which **teaches thee to profit**, which leads thee by the way that thou should go.

Psa 23:1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.

Pro 10:22 The blessing of the LORD, it makes rich, and he adds no sorrow with it.

3. Greater Blessings in the New Covenant.

Joh 10:10 I am come that they might have life better than they have ever dreamed. (Message) John 16:15 All things that the Father hath are mine:

Heb 1:2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all.

Rom 8:17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ

2Pe 1:3 As his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness.

Eph 1:3 God hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ.

2Co 8:9 For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.

Eph 3:20 Amp Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do **superabundantly**, far over and above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams]

D. Manifesting the Blessings

1. Know that God cannot break his word.

Is a 55:11 So shall my word be that goes forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing where I sent it.

Heb 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and for ever.

Rom 8:32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

2. Delight in the Lord.

Psa 37:4 Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart Psa 35:27 Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, who has pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.

Psa 37:4 Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

Psa 1:1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

Psa 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; in his law doth he meditate day and night.

Psa 1:3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

3. Be Patient.

Job 8:7 Though thy beginning was small, yet thy latter end should greatly increase.

Psa 115:14 The LORD shall increase you more and more, you and your children.

Heb 6:12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.
