1. What is Tithing?

a) Tithing is giving 10 percent of your income to God. Lev 27:30-32 b) The tithe belongs to God. Mal 3:8

2. Why should You Tithe?

a) Not tithing looses the devourer in your life. Haggai 1:6-9, Mal 3:9 b) Tithing breaks the curse on your life. Gen 4:3-7, Mal 3:11 c) It brings deliverance (Abraham; Achan). Gen 14:20; Josh 7:24-26 d) It brings healing. Jos 6:17-19;7:3;Ex 23:25

e) It is the doorway into the financial blessings of God. Mal 3:10

a) Treat the tithe as holy.
b) Confess your sins before you tithe.

d) Remind God that He has promised to bless us in this land of milk and honey.
